

Yavuz Elkin appointed as DenizBank Human Resources Senior Vice President

Yavuz Elkin will manage DenizBank Human Resources

Considering human resources as its most significant corporate value, DenizBank made a new appointment to strengthen its administrative staff in this field. Yavuz Elkin who has been working in DenizBank since 2004 will serve as Human Resources Senior Vice President as of May 2008.
